Summary	<p>In September 2015, the then level 2 SE London Joint Primary Care Committees approved the London Primary Care Commissioning Operating Model, following extensive engagement with CCGs and SPG leads, and subsequent endorsement by the Primary Care Management Board of NHS England (London).</p> <p>London's PCC Operating Model standardises responsibilities for decision making, reporting, committee governance, processes and capabilities, ensuring alignment with NHS England's (GP) Policy Guidance Manual https://www.england.nhs.uk/publication/primary-medical-care-policy-and-guidance-manual-pgm/ at all times</p> <p>The scope of this includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Practice mergers/ moves • APMS contracts • PMS reviews • Remedial and breach notices • CQC inadequate improvement plans • Contract termination (death, bankruptcy) • Contractual changes (contentions/ important) • Resilience and practice sustainability approaches • Local Improvement Schemes • PCN significant changes • Transactional contract changes (undertaken at officer level and reported to the next committee) <p>The London Operating Model was subsequently adopted by Borough/former CCG</p>
