Meetings of the Governing Body are held in public every two months. There is dedicated time at in-person meetings to enable members of the public to ask questions before and after each meeting.

Due to Government advice, we are not currently able to hold our Governing Body meetings in public. However, you can still:

1. submit questions related to the agenda of the upcoming meeting in writing. These will be responded to at the meeting or in written form afterwards and made available on the website. Please send them to: selccg.questions@nhs.net **by 5pm on two days before the next meeting.**
2. Watch the meeting live through Microsoft Teams. There will also be the ability to ask questions during the live event. You can find the link to view the next meeting [here](#).

To watch the meeting live, you will need to access the link to Microsoft Teams which is available on our website [here](#). To view the meeting, you will need to make you are using an internet browser which is compatible with Microsoft Teams. These are:

- Google Chrome
- Microsoft Edge
- Firefox.

Safari and Internet Explorer are not supported to use Microsoft Teams.

Asking questions

People can submit questions in one of two ways:

1. In advance of the meeting, using the instructions above, or
2. During the meeting.

To submit questions during the meeting, you will need to select ‘ask a question’ – this may display on your screen as ‘make an announcement’. This will bring up two boxes; the top one is

for your name (however, you can remain anonymous if you wish) and the second one is for your question.

The questions will be submitted via moderator. Not all questions submitted will necessarily be answered on the day. However, all questions and answers from each meeting will be published on the website.
