Executive Summary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • An analysis of the hospital discharges as recorded by the SPA during wave one (April to June 2020 inclusive). SPA Data has been utilised as a baseline, supplemented with data held by the local authority to inform an understanding of market demand pressures during the first wave. Namely those requiring Pathway 1 (short term home care) and Pathway 3 (residential or nursing home placements) • Inferences of volumes of provisions self-funded by residents and those publicly funded have been made to inform a wholistic understanding of the demand pressures on the market during this period. • Calculations of publicly funded provision provide a boroughwide cost implication for wave one. • Analysis of individual recipients of publicly funded services has allowed for clarity of ‘new’ demand specifically as a direct result of Covid. 	
Recommended action for the Committee	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Inform a shared understanding of the demand pressures following hospital discharges during wave one. • Agree the application of wave one proportional hospital discharge pathways to inform modelling of a second wave
