Executive Summary	<p>A letter was issued to all chief executives of NHS trusts, CCG accountable offers, GP practices, primary care networks and providers of community health and 111 services on July 31st 2020. This letter came from the Chief Executive of the NHS and the NHS Chief Operating Officer to thank everyone for the NHS response in face of the COVID-19 pandemic and to set out the next phase of response</p> <p>A1 - restore full operation of cancer services. Local cancer alliances to draw up rapid delivery plans for Sept20-Mar21</p> <p>A2 - recover maximum levels of elective activity, including restoring high levels and clearing backlogs of overnight and day cases, diagnostic procedures and outpatient appointments and follow ups, and using the independent sector hospitals</p> <p>A3 - restore service delivery in primary and community services, including proactive care of the most vulnerable, childhood imms and cervical screening, enhanced care in care homes, digital capabilities in primary care to continue, crisis response and rehab in the community, timely discharge processes, and resuming CHC assessments</p> <p>A4 - Improve MH and LD and autism services</p> <p>B1 - preparing for a second wave of Covid including PPE, IPC, testing and managing local outbreaks</p> <p>B2 - preparing for winter including bed capacity, flu vaccs, 111 First, A&E capital investments and working with councils</p> <p>C1 - Workforce for the above, as set out in the NHS People Plan 2020/21 and includes flexible working, staff mental health, looking after BAME staff, new ways of staff working and recruitment</p> <p>C2 - tackling the health inequalities and prevention that arose out of Covid</p> <p>Current financial arrangements have been extended to the end of September. Draft summary plans are required from local areas by 1st Sept and final plans by 21st Sept. These must be the product of partnership working across the ICS.</p>
