Also, the high rate of pressure sores in the quality report again I	The equipment provision in the post discharge pathways is provided through the same system and processes as all other health and social care equipment. This ensures patients can access the same equipment offer regardless of if they are in hospital or the community.

	<p>wanted to know about tissue viability team and the equipment available to them.</p>	<p>Patients who need it may be loaned equipment from the Integrated Community Equipment Service (ICES) following an assessment by Health or Social Care staff in accordance with each agency's eligibility criteria. There is a standard stock of equipment available which can be ordered. There is a range of pressure care equipment (mattresses and cushions) which are available to loan to patients by the community nursing team.</p> <p>All pressures ulcers graded 2 and above are reported as Serious Incidents and follows the national guidelines for reporting and investigating. All investigation reports are evaluated by the CCG where themes and trends are monitored and assurance obtained. Investigations take into consideration, diagnosis, nutrition, mobility, equipment and patient compliance. For some SI's immediate corrective measures need to be implemented such as equipment, increase turning cycles, improvement in nutrition.</p>
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
