Children & Young People Therapies – Implementing integrated commissioning	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Implementation of CCG/LBB integrated re-commissioning for Speech and Language Therapies, Occupational Therapy and Physiotherapy, establishing s.75 arrangements, following co-production with children, young people and families.• Implementation of the Marie Gascoigne SLT Review recommendations and CCG/LBB Action Plan• Work with education settings on an integrated commissioning framework for therapies• Work with BHC on increasing OT capacity to support outcomes for children and families and support LBB SEND requirements• KPIs to include improvements to the quality and timeliness of EHCPs, delivery of increased targeted and universal offer for children and young people's therapies
Community Paediatrics Review	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Work with BHC on the modernisation of Community Paediatrics Service – shift towards working in community, primary care settings and in schools• Review hospital to home pathways and hospital admissions for children identifying areas for further action• With BHC develop and agree new service specification
Recommissioning of Bromley Healthcare Children Contract (BHC Lot 3)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Review current specification and contract arrangements with BHC and with stakeholders• Research best practice in children's community health services to inform future commissioning intentions• Work with other SELCCG commissioners on the SEL Core Offer for children's services• Develop commissioning intentions across CCG and LBB• Review value and apportionment of LBB and CCG funding of the provision, establishing s.75 arrangements• Recommission service for 2023.
CAMHS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Develop and implement a post-Covid mental health and emotional wellbeing response for children and young people• Lead work to embed joint working across Bromley CAMHS/Bromley Y, with improvements to current triage and pathways• Roll out additional Wellbeing in Schools services to cover every school in Bromley• Respond to the CAMHS "deep dive" exercise into A&E referrals for children and young people, including with additional targeted work with education settings.• Develop an enhanced offer including expert consultation around cases from CAMHS/Bromley Y into children's social care and education.
