Executive Summary	<p>The integrated Children and Young People's hospital at home service pilot was launched in February 2021 for 18 months.</p> <p>The scheme will enable C&YP to receive their treatment and care in the most appropriate setting when acutely unwell, including within their home setting as an alternative to in-patient hospital care.</p> <p>The service was developed to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide more care in the family home. • Offer greater access to high quality child centred healthcare. • Reduce inpatient admissions and length of stay. • Develop an integrated service model. <p>The presentation is to outline the purpose of the pilot and progress to date.</p>
