

## Changes to how we share final vaccine schedules and daily LVS consumables delivery schedules

- Delivery schedules will no longer be shared by email through NVOG
- Final vaccine and consumables delivery schedules are now available on the Supply Planner in real time
- All sites must use the Supply Planner to view or amend vaccine orders, saving time and creating better visibility of when volume changes have been approved

Following the successful introduction of Supply Planner, the way we share information on final vaccine schedules is changing. All Regions, Systems and Sites are now able to access information previously shared on Excel Spreadsheets in real time using the Supply Planner. This is in addition to the ability to request an increase or decrease in vaccine volumes and/or cancel entire orders within the tool. Ultimately saving time and creating better visibility of when volume changes have been approved.

### LVS Final Vaccine Schedules

- The weekly LVS final vaccine schedule will no longer be sent out from the **w/c 23 August**.
- A weekly email alert will notify site users that initial plans have been confirmed, however they must check the Supply Planner to view initial volumes and to request an increase or decrease in those volumes.
- This will provide sites with a live view of their vaccine allocations and provide greater flexibility to edit allocations closer to the time of delivery.

### Daily LVS combined delivery schedule for the booster programme

- In preparation for the booster programme, we are developing the functionality for all sites to be able to access their ETAs for both vaccine and non-vaccine deliveries (when it is published) through the "Orders" tab in the Ordering Platform.
- This feature will be available for new site setup orders and for consumable replenishment for a limited time. Upcoming changes to non-vaccine consumables will be announced shortly.
- Once live we will end the daily cascade of delivery schedules, which are currently sent to each site Sunday to Thursday.
- All SVOCs and RVOCs will be able to generate their own reports using Supply Chain 360, to ensure they can continue to support sites with queries.
- We will not be switching off delivery schedules in the short-term and will inform you ahead of time when these are ending.

### Access to the Supply Planner

Gaining access to the Supply Planner will vary depending on your user type, please see the [Supply Planner Access Guide](#) for full instructions on how to get access. Please note this is on FutureNHS and you will be required to register if you do not have an account.
