As somebody who works with health data in London we'd like to invite you to our stakeholder events in January (held remotely on Teams platform) to develop a health data infrastructure (HDI) to improve hypertension care for Londoners.

HDI's have evolved across London each with successes and challenges and locally developed solutions and workarounds. This project will share learning across London to develop the most effective HDI solutions to support the project's aims of improving primary care hypertension detection and management with a focus on inequalities.

This project is led by Clinical Effectiveness Southeast London ([CESEL](#)) with support from colleagues in Northeast London (NEL) Clinical Effectiveness Group ([CEG](#)) and Integrated Care System ([ICS](#)) and colleagues from [NWL ICS](#).

Between event 1 and 2 each ICS (SEL, NEL, NWL) area will map their existing HDI guided by a co-developed framework from Event 1.

- How can we shape our HDI going forward?
