

# Self-neglect and Hoarding



**New half-day course for Southwark Housing and associated partners that provides an overview of the law relevant to self-neglect and hoarding.**

## What will it cover?

The course provides a brief reminder of the identification of self-neglect and hoarding, using this to see how law can apply. The course considers the balance to be struck between a consensual approach under legislation such as the Care Act 2014 – and interventions that may contain a “coercive” element in situations of escalating risk. And where this sits with human rights, in particular article 8 of the European Convention

- Care Act 2014; ;
- Mental Capacity Act 2005: Inherent jurisdiction of the Environmental health interventions: including Public Health Act 1936;
- Mental Health Act 1983:
- Police entry without warrant (life and limb, serious damage to property, s.17 PACE)
- Landlord role and interventions
- Animal Welfare Act – and relevance to self neglect/hoarding
