Diabetes recovery and hypertension inequalities funding: CESEL have secured funding for general practice teams to engage with improvement work, to help them deliver the best possible patient care and achieve QOF, DES and local incentives.

CESEL are co-delivering two of the [London Pathfinder Programmes](#):

- **Hypertension:** CESEL are leading a project with colleagues across NEL and NWL on how to use data to drive best possible hypertension care, underpinned by patient engagement. A report is due in December, which will inform the London Data Strategy.
- **CHIME:** working with colleagues from NEL, twelve GP teams across Lambeth, Southwark, Bromley and Lewisham have volunteered, and will be funded, to test an innovative call and recall tool to improve childhood immunisation update and achieve targets.

New clinical areas: CESEL are collaborating with colleagues from Medicines Optimisation Team and London Kidney Network (LKN) to develop a CESEL Chronic Kidney Disease Guide. Asthma has also been highlighted as a priority area for support, and the team are scoping plans for producing a CESEL Guide for later in the year.

Support for your patients with diabetes to achieve 8 care processes: CESEL Bromley Clinical Leads have recently made a short [patient support film](#) to share with all patients with Type 2 diabetes, reminding them why the 8 care processes are so important and to make sure they attend their diabetes review.
